Finding a use and a beauty in the ephemera of the everyday has become like an alchemic practice. Using the materials that are all around is an important and direct comment on the textures of our households and rituals. The work evolves through documenting, recording, collecting and sharing these stories.

I use various processes to create, drawn to processes that have some element of surprise in the outcome. Scavenging, papermaking, natural dye and ink making, drawing, cyanotype and creating book structures are amalgamated together to produce small and perfectly formed keepsakes that echo the essence of the materials and story they communicate. My ethos dictates that it is important to waste nothing, that everything has a purpose and an inherent beauty to be examined, explored, elevated and a new purpose discovered.

My work includes sculpture, multimedia installation, and live art. I use these different forms to explore the concept

of liminality and threshold, the synergy of the senses, and to invite the audience into the space that exists between certainties.

I have an affinity with wire, which I weld or weave into routes and voids, implying both connection and disconnection. Steel becomes weightless, organic and ethereal. The addition of light and sound creates immersive environments of bodies within bodies, disembodied, transient beings.

I engage my own body, both as medium and tool, as I draw out my ideas – both three-dimensionally with wire or other fibres and textures, and in negotiating boundaries with other human bodies through collaborative and performative voice and movement. This way I contemplate the way the viewer connects with their own body – the immediate sensation, empathy, reflection, agency and action.
